

THE BRIDGE INN FISHERY.

(Including: HALL WALK LAKES)

TOM'S LAKE. (8 acres - Season Ticket Holders Only)

About 9 of the original Carp left from 27lbs - 40lbs+, (including a 30lb + common.) 65 of our English bred Scaley Carp have now been introduced ranging from 12 - 20lbs.
Tench: 9lb 12oz, Bream: 10lb 6oz, Rudd: 2lb 14oz, Pike: 24lb 8oz , Perch, Roach, Eels.

A challenging water due to low stock levels, natural food supply, reed beds & lilies. Averages 4ft – 6ft with 9ft+ in the “Keyhole”, can be very weedy during the summer.
Tips : The fish follow the wind. Search out the gravel bars and don't ignore the margins.

PUPPY LAKE. (1½ acres - Season Tickets & Guests)

40+ English bred Scaley Carp ranging from 12 – 19lbs, some smaller Carp to 6 lb.
Shoals of small Rudd, the occasional Bream or Tench and some very big Perch.

Predominately a small lake for Carp, depths from 3ft – 6ft, a good “floater” water.
Tips : Fish to the island or tight to the trees. Best bait = Pellets & “Bridge Inn Specials”.

LONG LAKE. (2 acres - Season Tickets & Guests)

400+ English bred Scaley Carp ranging from 3 – 8lbs, Bream: 9lbs, Tench: 9lbs,
Roach, Rudd, Perch, Pike and Eels.

A true mixed fishery with 100lbs+ bags of Bream & Carp possible, depths from 3ft – 7ft.
Tips : Fish from ½ way up the lake to the top end by the reeds. Pole, float or feeder.
Worm, pellet, catfood or corn; use groundbait to hold your fish and feed regularly!

BRIDGE LAKE. (5 ½ acres - Day Tickets Available £7-50)

Carp, (both commons and mirrors), ranging from 12 – 37lbs, average around 15 lbs.
Tench: 9lb 8oz, Bream: 13lb 2oz, Pike: 26lb 10oz, Crucians: 4lb 8oz, Perch & Roach.

A mature gravel pit with an island, reed beds, fallen trees, gravel bars & plateaus.
Depths range from 4ft – 10ft. Commons to 20lbs+ have fallen to “floaters” and both ends of the lake can fish well at different times of the year. A relatively easy carp water.

Tips: Fish to the pads or under the trees in the margins. Most standard rigs work well.
Best bait = A good quality boilie or pop-up – (“Bridge Inn Specials”), tipped with corn.

“L” POND. (½ acre - Day Tickets Available £7-50)

A match/pleasure pond, heavily stocked with a mix of Roach, Rudd, Skimmers, Perch, Carp, Tench and even a few Crucians. Nothing much over 5lbs in weight.

With depths of only 3ft max this makes it ideal for youngsters to learn our sport.

Tips: Float fish just off the bottom with red maggot, caster or corn. Feed little & often.

THE CANAL. (½ acre – Day Tickets Available £7-50)

Mainly a “silver fish” match/pleasure pond stocked with Roach, Rudd & Skimmers.
A few small Carp, Tench and Crucians. Fish to 2½lbs in weight.

With a width of only 25ft and depths varying from 2ft – 5ft this is an ideal pole venue.
Easily fishable & heavily stocked, this makes it an ideal fun water for novices or experts.

Tips: Novices – Float fish maggot just touching the bottom and feed lightly.

Experts – Pole it tight to the far side: caster for better quality fish.

RIVER WENSUM. (Day Tickets Available £7-50)

Barbel to a near record 19lb 8oz. Chub to 7lb 6oz & Roach to an incredible 3lb 6½ oz. Perch: 3lb 2oz, Grayling: 2lb 4oz, Pike to nearly 20lbs and even the odd Brownie!

Our exclusive stretch of the legendary river Wensum nestles between two private beats and reaches over 300 yds from the road bridge to the Iron bridge at Marriott's Way. Heavily weeded during the summer months; fish can be caught from the gravel glides or the 2 deeper holes by the "bend" or the Iron bridge. The best fishing is to be had in the winter, especially when fining down from flood or snow water.

Tips : Two schools of thought really... "Tip it" or "Trott it". (Both have their days)

The Barbel are usually found under the trees on the far bank ½ way down the stretch.

They soon wise up being caught from the deeper holes. A large Halibut pellet over a bed of hemp & pellet has been the norm for the last few seasons, but don't be afraid to experiment – they love spicy and garlicky meat, big old lobworms & even the odd boilie. Dusk is definitely a better period to fish for them than early morning sessions.

Chub will pick up any bait – bread and cheese pastes are the regular's favourites.

The Roach tend to favour the 2 deep holes, try strett-pegging a stick float or avon at 1 ½ times the depth, feed caster & hemp with red maggot, hemp or tares as hook bait.

Top Tip : Them big Roach always hang back... As dusk approaches; change to a large piece of bread flake, shallow up and run it through your swim.
